## The Respethical Mind...

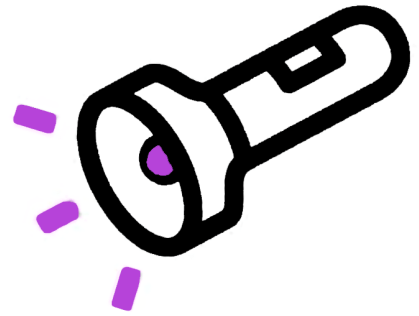
binds together respect and ethics and how they contribute to society

# The Respethical Mind



## How can educators model the respethical mind?

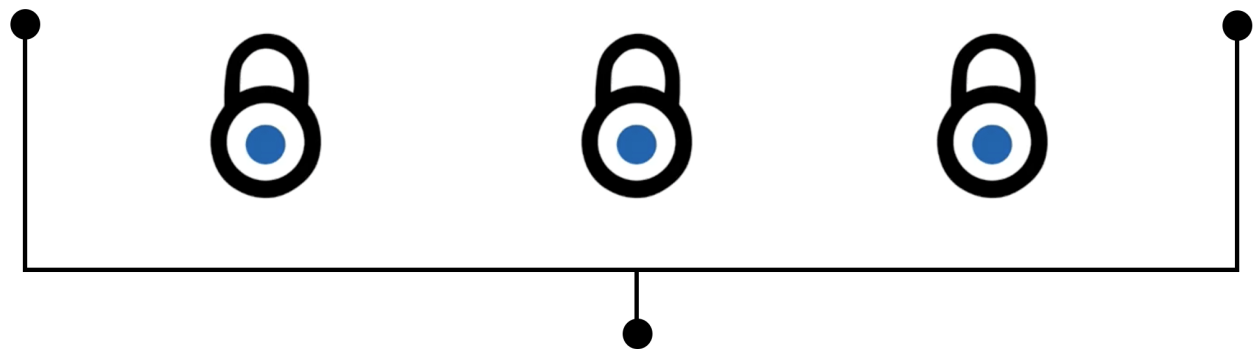
Provide role models and offer lessons that show how we should treat each other.

Avoid thinking of a group in terms.

Be open to the possibily of being wrong.

Offer the benefit of the doubt.

Avoid displaying false respect.



Assign students to work together, allowing them to get to know each other, acknowledge differences, and recognize that respectful debates and disagreements are ok.



Assign students books, movies, and works of art that show how respect is modeled and fostered between individuals and in groups.
