How to Sign Up for Mizzou Mandarin Class

Three levels of instruction are offered:

Level 1 is for those who have no learning experience in Chinese, beginners.

Level 2 is designed for those who have some learning experience in Chinese. It is designed to help improve the understanding of both Chinese language and culture.

Level 3 is aimed at those who are proficient to a certain extent, and have studied Chinese for a couple of years or more. This level strives to further develop the participants' Chinese language skills and cultural knowledge to a higher level.
